Dental

On February 7, 2014, dental staff participated in Give Kids a Smile Day. Sealants were placed on 2nd and 3rd grade children from Gamewell Elementary that were selected through screenings by the state hygienist. 12 children were seen and 54 sealants were placed. On February 28, dental staff provided care at Lower Creek Preschool. They conducted a presentation educating children on the dental office and maintaining good oral hygiene. On November 13th, dental staff participated in the NC Baptist Men Mobile Medical/Dental Ministry bus. They provided dental services to uninsured and underserved residents on the dental bus located at First Baptist Church in Lenoir.
