Clinic/Lab

- **186 women** were screened through the Breast and Cervical Cancer Control program.
- Staff participated in the annual flu drive-thru clinic and gave over 170 flu shots.
- Participated in a “tracker” QI project. This tool developed during Practice Management allows clinic staff to “track” patients from check-in to when they are prepped for the examiner. The tracker was tested and proven to be an improvement for our clinic.

Women's Health



Caldwell County Health Department Women's Health team partnered with UNC Chapel Hill Center for Maternal and Infant Health to provide specialized maternal-fetal medicine consultation by telemedicine. Maternity patients can receive consultation without having to travel beyond their local health department. The consultation visits are for maternity patients that are receiving care at the health department with complications such as chronic disease, tobacco use, and previous adverse pregnancy outcomes. The goal of this program is to provide the best care possible for our patients.

Dental

- February: Give Kids A Smile Completed 50 free sealants on 13 children from Gamewell Elementary and offered free fluoride varnish to all 2nd and 3rd grade students at Gamewell Elementary
- September: Completed dental screenings at Creative Beginnings Head Start in Morganton
- October: New operatory was installed which allows for increased patient volume, decreased wait time, and better patient flow
- November: Spoke about oral care for pregnant women and infants at Caldwell Pregnancy Care Center



Health Education

- Produced 12 TV Shows on the local government channel with an additional 9 animal adoption TV shows.
- Successfully completed 1 series of Chronic Disease Self Management classes , 1 series of Diabetes Self Management classes and 1 Matter of Balance class.
- Safe Kids partnered with Smart Start to provide car seats to families in need. With grant funds we were able to provide car seats, pack n plays, sleep sacks, baby gates and co-sleep beds to families in need, educating them on Safe Sleep.
- An average of 70 county employees participate in the Positive Pulse, wellness incentive program.
- 62 people participated in the Biggest Loser Challenge.
- 15 County employees registered for the 4th annual Couch to 5K.
