

**NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION
CALDWELL COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

The statewide general election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote. All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at ncsbe.gov/voter-id.


Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them beginning September 6, 2024. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at votebymail.ncsbe.gov, or by filling out a request form provided by the board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Caldwell County Board of Elections by 5 p.m. October 29, 2024.

In the general election, voters will select candidates for **U.S. President, U.S. House of Representatives, N.C. Governor, N.C. General Assembly, state and local judges, district attorney, and county offices.**

The voter registration deadline for this election is 5 p.m. Friday, October 11, 2024. Eligible individuals who are not registered by that deadline may register and vote at one of our early

voting sites during the early voting period. New registrants will be required to provide documentation of their residence.
