Expiring Permits

A permit issued pursuant to G.S. 153-A-357 expires six months, or any lesser time fixed by ordinance of the county, after the date of issuance if the work authorized by the permit has not commenced. If after the commencement, the work is discontinued for a period of 12 months, the permit therefore immediately expires. No work authorized by a permit that has expired may thereafter be performed until a new permit has been secured. (G.S. 153A-358). Therefore, the following fees will be charge for permits that are allowed to expire:

- 1) Permit expiring six months after issuance:
 - a. A new, second permit will be issued within six months of the expiration date of the fire permit 50.00 per permit

- b. Time that lapses beyond six months of the expiration date Full amount of fees
- 2) Permit expiring after a year with no work being done:
 - a. A new, second permit will be issued Full amount of fees

There shall be no initial fee for fire inspection of Level I, II, or III properties required under the NC State Fire Code mandatory inspection schedule. Thirty (30) days following the initial fire inspection, a re-inspection shall be conducted by the fire official. If all violations of the fire code have been corrected, no fee shall be imposed. If all violations of the fire code have not been corrected (or a reasonable attempt to correct has not been made), a second notice to comply shall be issued and a fee of \$50.00 shall be imposed. Seven (7) days following the issuance of the second order to comply, the fire official shall return for a re-inspection. If all

violations have not been corrected, a final notice shall be issued and an additional fee of \$100.00 shall be imposed. Seven (7) days following the issuance of the final notice, the fire official shall return for a re-inspection. If all violations have not been corrected, and/or all fees have not been paid, the fire inspector shall initiate criminal proceedings, if necessary, to bring the establishment into compliance with the NC Fire Code.

Licensed Care Facility Public Assist Fee- \$250.00

A non-emergent lift assist fee will be assessed to individuals & licensed care facilities each time Caldwell County EMS personnel help pick up a subject that has fallen and has no apparent injuries or emergent medical needs.

A lift assist requires no additional medical evaluation or transport to an emergency room, only to lift the resident from one surface (i.e. the floor) to another (i.e. a bed or chair).

Individuals will be charged \$100.00 per incident after 5 documented public assists in a one (1) year period. The one (1) year period will run by calendar year. Caldwell County EMS will reconcile a monthly report on public assist incidents and bill the individual based on the number of public assist response(s) greater than 5 in the calendar year.

Licensed Care Facilities will be charged \$250.00 per incident. This charge is intended to be a disincentive for the practice of using publicly- funded emergency services to provide non-emergent assistance to a licensed care facility.

PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS

Duplication and Mailing Fees; Special Service Charges:

If the requestor has asked for copies of the public records to be produced in writing, then prior to the release of copies, the County will collect any applicable duplication and delivery fees. **The**

County will not charge for the costs of paper copies unless they exceed 25 pages. The following is the current fee schedule for copies of public records:

- 8 ½ x 11” single-sided hardcopy: \$0.10 per page (Black and White) and \$0.25 per page (Color)
- DVD Duplication of Meeting: At-cost for purchase of the DVD
- USB flash drive: At-cost for purchase of the USB flash drive, dependent on size of the USB flash drive needed
- Standard US Postal Service first-class mailing fees will be charged for mailing copies of public records to any requester, except that the County will not charge for mailings that cost less than \$0.70

A special service charge may apply if:

- Responding to the records request requires extensive use of information technology resources or extensive clerical or supervisory assistance by County personnel, and/or
- Producing the records in the particular medium requested results in a greater use of information technology resources than that established by the County for reproduction of the volume of information requested. See G.S. §132-6.2(b).

**Multiple requests within a short period of time from the same individual or organization may be considered a single request for purposes of determining whether a special service charge is applicable. The special service charge will be reasonable and no greater than the actual costs incurred. The County will work with the requestor to execute a contract agreeing to the special service charge, with a 50-percent deposit required prior to staff beginning the process of fulfilling the request.
